In their book inviting School Success, Purkey and Novak (1984) set fourth four types of teacher behaviors toward students.

- 1- Intentionally Disinviting
- 2- Unintentional Disinviting
- 3- Unintentionally Inviting
- **4-Intentionally Inviting**

Teacher behaviors can be verbal or nonverbal, formal or informal and continuously transmitted to students.

Inviting behaviors/comments convey to students that they are responsible, able, and valuable.

Disinviting behaviors/comments convey to students that they are irresponsible, incapable, and worthless.
